Ed M^c Kinney made application for a transfer to be made to him, in lieu of the license now issued in favor of J. H. Cosgrove, to sell liquor at # 435 Main Street from May 1st A.D. 1906 to Oct. 17th A.D. 1906 said application was referred to the License Committee.

Chuloutoa Ave

George Sanders and several other business men petitioned to have Chuloutoa street in Crawford addition extended north to Colorado Avenue in Mobleys addition, said petition was referred to the Street and Alley Committee.

Petition for King on 8th + White.

James A. Johnson and others petitioned to have a street crossing laid on the south side of White Ave. on 8th street, between blocks 92 and 93, said petition was referred to the Street and Alley Committee.

Henry Auling and several others petitioned to have the water main extended on Hood street from 12th eastward to the east line of the city, said petition was referred to the water & sewers Committee.

Chamber of
Commerce.

The Chamber of Commerce presented a communication, to the Council stating that their respective body had passed a motion, tendering their support to the city Council on any plan they would adopt for the thorough clearing up of our city on some date in the near future, the Campaign not to be for one day but for the season. also the following communication was received from the Chamber of Commerce and read. At a regular meeting of the Board of Directors of the Chamber of Commerce held Friday evening April 20th 1906 a motion prevailed instructing the Secy of the board to call the attention of your Hon. body to the condition of the brick sidewalk just east of the excelsior laundry on main street. the Complaint made is that the walk is in bad order, also that the water discharged from the boiler of the laundry frequently floods this section of the walk making it at such times in bad condition for use. said Communications were ordered placed on record.

Alderman Smith made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt, that the street & alley Com. confer with the County Commissioners, in regard to laying of sidewalks along their property on the east & West side of north 7th street between White & Grand streets upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

100 Inches of
Water Bought

Alderman Norris made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt that the Street Commissioner be empowered to buy 100 Inches of water for to be used for the City ditches upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

The matter of allowing private parties to use the City ~~water~~ ditches to convey water through was discussed and the same was referred to the Judiciary Com.

Alderman Norris made a motion seconded by Alderman Boyle to take a recess for ten minutes upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
