

Grand Junction Colo. April 27th A.D. 1906

Roll Call The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened pursuant to adjournment from April 25th A.D. 1906. Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Davies, Mc Culloch, Norris, Boyle, Platt and City Atty N.E. Coles, Alderman Smith arrived late, absent Atkins and Lutes.

Minutes The minutes of previous meeting were read corrected and so approved.

City Atty Coles reported that he was unable to go to Greeley and other Cities, as instructed by Council and substituted B.W. Vedder to go in his place.

Blacksmith Work to be distributed. Alderman Smith made a motion seconded by Alderman Norris, that the blacksmithing work of the City, be equally distributed to the parties interested, as the officers in charge of the different departments, in their best judgment sees fit, upon call of motion, said motion carried unanimously.

Executive Session. Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Alderman Smith that Council go into executive session upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Alderman Smith made a motion seconded by Alderman Norris to return to regular order of business, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Appr for Water Alderman Platt made a motion seconded by Alderman Norris, that \$1500.00 Fifteen hundred dollars be appropriated, for preliminary survey, for extension of water system, and one thousand dollars \$1000.00 to secure water rights for extension of present system, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Adjourn Alderman Platt made a motion seconded by Alderman Norris to adjourn until 8 P.M. May 9th A.D. 1906, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
