Roll Call

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened at a regular session thereof, Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present Alderman Davies, Jutes, M^o. Culloch, Boyle & Platt, Alderman Alker, Norris & Smith arrived a few minutes late.

Sidewalk to be laid on South + 6th

Chairman Platt of the Street & Alley Committee reported favorable, upon laying a board sidewalk on South + Sixth streets, thereupon Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Alderman Jutes that the report of Committee be sustained and sidewalk be ordered laid, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
