

Grand Junction Colo. May 25th, A. D. 1906.

Roll call

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened pursuant to adjournment of May 23rd, Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present. Alderman Davies, M^c. Culloch, Norris, Boyle & Smith, absent Alkire, Lutes & Platt

Minutes

The minutes of meetings held May 16th and May 23rd, were read and approved.

Alderman Davies made a motion seconded by Alderman Norris to refer to unfinished business, upon call of motion, said motion carried unanimously.

Coal Bids

The following bids for coal to be delivered at the pump house bins, were opened and read, Cameo coal Co. Mine Run \$2²⁰ per ton, Slack \$1²⁰ per ton, The Palisade Coal & Supply Co. Mine Run \$2²⁵ per ton, Slack \$1²⁵, The Utah Fuel Co Mine Run \$2⁵⁵ per ton, Slack \$1⁵⁵ per ton, The Book Cliff Railroad, Mine Run \$1⁸⁷ Slack \$1³⁶ per ton.

Alderman Smith made a motion seconded by Alderman M^c. Culloch, that the coal contract be let to the lowest bidder which was the Book Cliff Railroad, upon call of motion vote was as follows, Alderman Davies yea, M^c. Culloch yea, Norris yea, Boyle yea, Smith yea, motion carried.

A verbal request was made by a citizen for a box trough to be laid in the ditch, where the alley runs between Curway & Chipata streets on the west side of 11th Street, and that the street in front of his house be filled in. Said request was referred to the Street & Alley Committee.

Bill allowed

A Bill for \$15⁰⁰ rental for Auditorium was read, thereupon Alderman Davies made a motion seconded by Alderman ~~Davies~~ Boyle that the bill be allowed and warrant drawn for same, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
