

Grand Junction Colorado Aug. 9<sup>th</sup>. A.D. 1906.

The City Council of the City of Grand

Junction convened pursuant to adjournment from Aug. 8<sup>th</sup> A.D. 1906.  
Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Lutes, M<sup>c</sup> Culloch, Norris, O'Boyle, and Platt, Alderman Alkire & Smith arrived a few minutes late, absent Alderman Davies.

The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

alderman Platt made a motion seconded by alderman Alkire to suspend the regular order of business and proceed to take up the question of mountain water, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Upon the invitation of Mayor Bunting messrs Theodore Rosenberg, Louis C. Kelsey, Frank Schwallbach and Colonel Willard Young appeared before the Council and explained their qualifications for the position of hydraulic engineer for the mountain water system.

Chairman O'Boyle of the special water Committee recommended Willard Young and Frank C. Kelsey for the position of Hydraulic Engineers for the construction of the mountain water system. Thereupon Alderman Lutes made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt that the report of Chairman O'Boyle of the special water Committee be confirmed and adopted, upon call of roll vote was as follows, Alderman Alkire yea, Lutes yea, M<sup>c</sup> Culloch yea, Norris yea, O'Boyle yea, Platt yea, Smith yea, motion carried.

Alderman Lutes made a motion seconded by Alderman Alkire that Council enter into a contract with Young & Kelsey for the engineering work of extending and enlarging our present Water system and Plant, upon call of roll vote was as follows, Alderman Alkire yea, Lutes yea, M<sup>c</sup> Culloch yea, Norris yea, O'Boyle yea, Platt yea, Smith yea, motion carried.

Alderman Norris made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt to adjourn until 8 P.M. Aug. 10<sup>th</sup>. A.D. 1906 upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
