

Grand Junction Colo. August 22<sup>nd</sup> A.D. 1906.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session, Mayor Crunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Davies, Lutes, Norris, O'Boyle & Platt, absent alkira, M<sup>c</sup> Culloch & Smith.

The minutes of previous meetings Aug. 9<sup>th</sup> and Aug. 10<sup>th</sup> were read and approved.

The petition signed by L. J. Kuhn and 14 others owning lots on Peller avenue between 4<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup> streets, was read, they requested that Peller avenue be opened up, brush cleared off and graded, said petition was referred to the street and alley Committee.

George W. Hutton <sup>owner of 2 lots</sup> and the owners of 8 other lots petitioned to have a Cement sidewalk ordered laid on the south half of Block 63, from 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> street on Curay ave, this petition was referred to the street and alley Committee.

J. N. Harris and wife were present and requested that the sidewalk grade in front of their property on 5<sup>th</sup> & Colo. ave. be lowered so as to not injure their property, and that they would refuse to lay a sidewalk until this was done. this matter was referred to the street and alley Com. and street supervisor for adjustment.

Proposed Ordinance No. 139 <sup>Corrected and</sup> was read at length, in open Council, thereupon Alderman Lutes made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt, that proposed Ordinance No. 139 as read and Corrected be ordered published preceding final passage, as by law required, upon call of roll vote was as follows, Alderman Davies yea, Lutes yea, Norris yea, O'Boyle yea, Platt yea. motion Carried.
