Pet. to oust tents on 4th & Pitkin

A Petition signed by Josephine Duskey and others was read, requesting the Council to take action for the removal of the tents located at the corner of 4th & Pitkin streets on account of the unsanitary conditions prevalent there, said petition was referred to the Board of Health.

Pet. to extend signs over 3 feet

A. F. Schully petitioned for the privilege of placing electrical signs to extend about 6 feet over the sidewalks from the store buildings, this was referred to the Committee on Fire & Police

Pet. to open up West Grand Ave.

S. W. Berry and several others petitioned to have West Grand Ave. opened up from 1st street to the Rio Grande Western Ry. said petition was referred to the Street and Alley Committee. R.R. Co to be served with sidewalk notice

Alderman Norris entered a complaint about the sidewalks not being laid in Crawford addition, after considerable discussion, alderman Davies made a motion seconded by alderman Smith that the Denver & Rio Grande Ry Co be served with a notice to lay a sidewalk across their property on Colorado Ave. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
