The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session, Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Davies, Lutes, M^c Culloch, Boyle, Platt and Smith. absent Alker and Norris.

The minutes of Oct. 10th and Oct. 16th were read and approved.

Sidewalk ordered laid on south half of Block 63

Alderman Platt reported favorable upon the petition of E.A. Krohn and others to have a cement sidewalk ordered laid on the south half of block 63, thereupon Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Alderman M^c Culloch that the report be accepted and the sidewalk be ordered laid upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Old safe to be advertised for sale.

A communication was read signed by W^m Campbell offering \$100.00 for the safe owned by the city and now at the fire hall.
