Bids for construction to be left to the Water Com.

Alderman Lutes made a motion seconded by Alderman Platt that the advertising for bids for the construction of and enlargement of the water system be left to the special water committee and that said bids be received up to and including Nov. 28th and opened and read upon that date, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
