

Grand Junction Colo. Nov. 30th a. D. 1906

The City Council of the City of

Grand Junction, Colo. convened in regular adjourned session
Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following
responded present aldermen alkire, Davis, Lutz, M. C. Callach
Norris, Platt + Smith. ald. Boyle arrived a few minutes later.

The minutes of previous meeting
were read and approved.

Roll Call

John Brainard granted permission to build coal shed. Ald. Norris reported favorable upon the petition of John Brainard to erect a coal shed in the rear of The Pastime Cafe. thereupon Ald. Platt made a motion seconded by Ald. Futra that said report be accepted and affirmed upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Bids for Construction
Kannah Creek pipe line rejected. Ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Platt that all bids presented opened and read for the construction of the Kannah Creek pipe line and reservoir be rejected. upon call of roll vote was as follows, Ald. Alkire yea, Davies yea, Futra yea, M. C. Culloch yea, Norris yea, Platt yea, Smith yea, motion carried.

Ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Futra that an advertisement be inserted in the papers in the near future time to be subject to the will of bidders present, and that the advertisement read that all wire wound pipe be made at Grand Junction or adjacent to the pipe line, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Advertise for Bids Kannah Creek pipe line second time. Ald. M. C. Culloch made a motion seconded by Ald. Alkire, that bids for the construction of the Kannah Creek pipe and reservoir be advertised for, the same to be received up to eight o'clock P.M. Dec. 12th, A.D. 1906. and the clerk to note on each bid the time received. upon call of roll vote was as follows Ald. Alkire yea, Davies yea, Futra yea, M. C. Culloch yea, Norris yea, Boyle yea, Platt yea, Smith yea. motion carried.

Atty Fry asks to have Geo. Smith's franchise extended. Attorney Fry was present and stated that he represented some parties that might possibly finance the building of an electric railway, wherein George Smith holds the franchise granted by the City of Grand Junction. providing they would signify their willingness to extend the present franchise for sixty days. thereupon Ald. Smith made a motion that it is the sense of this Council that on application for an extension of franchise held by George Smith to this Council the same would be granted no second.

Adjourn. Ald. Boyle made a motion to adjourn until next regular meeting seconded by Ald. Platt upon call of roll vote was as follows Ald. Alkire yea, Davies yea, Futra nay, M. C. Culloch yea, Norris nay, Boyle yea, Platt yea, Smith nay motion carried.
