Roll Call

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session, Mayor Bunting presiding upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Akira, Davies, Lutes, M.C. Cullock, Morris, Boyle, Platt & Smith. *The Minutes of previous meeting*
Wallis resigns ~~was read and approved.~~ City Marshal C.H. Wallis presented a written petition to council requesting them to accept his resignation to take effect January 1st 1907. Ald. Morris made a motion seconded by ald. Akira that the resignation of C.H. Wallis be accepted, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

The following applications were read to fill the vacancy of City Marshal after Jan. 1st 1907. Geo. T. Poupain, G.P. Rogers, and T.C. O'Neil they were referred to the Fire and Police Com.

a petition was read from the Grand Junction Feed & Prost of Grand Imp. Co by W.E. Dudley Pres. and Josephine Rich protesting against the Jct. Feed & Imp. Co. erection of the building now being erected on lots 7 & 8 Block 116 claiming against building that the same is being done contrary to the Ordinances of the City, erected on lots 7 & 8 Block 116 and without authority of the City Council, Judge Van Hoornenke appeared as counsel for the Grand Jct. Feed & Imp. Co. ald. Platt made a motion seconded by ald. Smith that the construction of the building being erected on lots 7 & 8 Block 116 be stopped until further consideration of Council, upon call of motion vote was as follows ald. Akira nay, Davies nay, Lutes nay, M.C. Cullock nay, Morris nay, Boyle nay Platt yea Smith yea, motion lost.

Chief Rogers

The Chief Rogers requested Council to pass a resolution, compelling the Grand Junction Electric & Gas Co. to have one of their employers to attend each fire alarm sounded prepared to cut any wires that may be necessary, also to pass an ordinance not to allow any building to be erected beyond 25 feet in width without putting in a wall less than 12 inches in thickness the same to extend 2 1/2 feet above the roof, both requests were referred to the Fire & Police Com.

Chairman Davies of the Water and lights Com.

Fruit & Fairassen reported upon the petition of the Fruit and Fairassen in regard to to pay for water water used by them, he recommended that the water Dept proceed to collect the money due from the Fruit and Fairassen, therupon Ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Alkin that the report of Chairman Davies be confirmed and sustained, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

There was considerable discussion in regard to what action to pursue for the building of a pipe line for mountain water, J. J. Lumsden submitted a proposition to Council making an offer to complete the system exclusive of reservoir using No. 12 Gauge steel riveted pipe for \$262.567 and further he proposed to furnish all labor and implements necessary for the construction and completion of said work for the sum of \$112.252. or to furnish all tools and implements and supervise said construction for ten per cent of the cost of same, the special water Com. were granted further time to make investigations.

The written opinion of City Atty H. E. Coles was read in regard to the City building the water system themselves, his opinion stated they could that it was within the province of the City Council to build it.

The Grand Junction Electric & Gas Company by Charles S. Newton President filed a written acceptance and agreement of Ordinance No. 140 granting said Company a franchise, the same was read in full by the Clerk and ordered filed in the office of City Clerk, in which acceptance said Company agrees to perform and abide by all the conditions of said Ordinance.

Chairman Morris of the fire and police Com. reported that said committee recommended the appointment of C. C. O'Neil to fill the vacancy of City Marshal after Jan 1st 1907 Ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Gates that the report of Chairman Morris be accepted upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Alderman Morris made a motion seconded

by ald. alkire that C.C. O'Neil be made City Marshal after Jan.
1st 1907. upon call of motion vote was as follows ald. alkire yea,
Davies yea. Lutes yea. M^c Culloch yea. Morris yea. Boyle yea. Platt yea.
Smith yea. motion carried.

to adjourn until Dec. 26th upon call of motion said motion Carried
unanimously.
