Roll Call

Convened in first regular monthly session Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present Alderman Alkerie, Davies, Mc Culloch, Norris, Platt and Smith, Ald. Lutes arrived a few minutes late. absent Ald. Boyle.

Minutes

The minutes of Jan. 23rd and Feb. 1st were read and approved.

Reports Officers

The following monthly reports of officers were read and referred to the finance committee. Police Magistrate, City Clerk City Treasurer, City weigher and water Dept.

City Tr. Co. allowed to build shed

Ald. Norris reported favorable upon the petition of the City Tr. Co. to build a Corrugated shed on the rear of their Barn located on lots 17+18 Block 120. thereupon Ald. Mc Culloch made a motion seconded by Ald. Lutes that the report be accepted and affirmed. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

F. R. Gatt allowed to build Ice Box

Ald. Norris reported favorable upon the petition of F. R. Gatt to build a wooden ice box 8x12 by 10 feet high on lot 13 Block 143, thereupon Ald. Lutes made a motion seconded by Ald. Smith that the report be accepted and affirmed upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

City atty authorized to secure deed for street

City atty Colea made a verbal report in regard to the opening up of Lawrence ave in Cranford add stating that the cost would be \$5⁰⁰ for the land and the payment of the back taxes, Ald. Norris made a motion seconded by Ald. Platt that the City atty secure a deed for same and that the street be opened up. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Tr from salary to S or Fund

For the construction of the line per specifications as amended the sum of \$258,000.
