Roll Call

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session at the hour of 1<sup>30</sup> pursuant to the foregoing call. Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present Alderman Alkire, Davies, Lutes, M<sup>c</sup>. Culloch, Norris, Boyle & Platt absent Alderman Smith.

The matter of disposing of the Bonds was brought up by Ald. Boyle, Mr. Gordon was present and upon request made a short talk stating what the Bond company he represented would do in regard to taking the Bond issue.

Mayor Bunting called President of the Council Boyle to the chair, and then <sup>the Mayor</sup> took the floor and stated to the Council his position in regard to selling the Bonds and etc.

Resolution reconsidered

Alderman Norris made a motion seconded by Alderman Alkire to reconsider the resolution as passed in special meeting held Feb. 16<sup>th</sup> regarding the awarding of Contract and acceptance of the proposal made by the Mitchell Engineering and Building Company for the construction of the proposed Kannah Creek pipe line, and the purchase of the Bonds for same. upon call of roll vote was as follows. Alkire yea. Davies yea. Lutes yea, M<sup>c</sup>. Culloch yea, Norris yea. Boyle yea, Platt yea, motion carried.

Resolution rescinded

Alderman Norris made a motion seconded by Alderman Lutes, that the portion of the original resolution be rescinded, as follows to-wit: "They to take the Three Hundred thousand (\$300,000.00) dollar Bond issue at par for Cash; to be deposited at designated fiscal institutions of this City by the Mayor to the order of the City Treasurer for their work, The first issue shall consist of One Hundred Thousand (\$100,000.00) dollars, payable within fifteen days from the signing of the contract, the balance in four equal payments of Fifty Thousand (\$50,000.00) dollars each, as the City may require." upon call of roll vote was as follows Alderman Alkire yea. Davies yea. Lutes yea, M<sup>c</sup>. Culloch yea, Norris yea, Boyle yea, Platt yea motion carried.

Alderman Boyle made a motion seconded by Ald. Lutes to adjourn without day, upon call of motion said motion carried unananimously.
