Ed. M^c Cary petitioned Council for a permit to

Counter petition

a Counter petition was filed by atty Greer in

against bldg. RR. track across South ave.

behalf of residents and taxpayers living in the vicinity of South ave between 6th & 7th St. protesting against granting Geo. J. D. Williams et al extending a railroad track across South St. this was referred to the S & A. Com.

Mrs. J. J. Horlin to build screen porch

Mrs. J. J. Horlin requested that a permit be granted her to erect a screen porch on the rear of the Unanap hotel This was referred to the F. & P. Com.

Walks ordered laid along north side Cikapita ave bet 3 & 4

Chairman Platt of the S & A Com. recommended that walks be ordered laid along the north side of Cikapita ave. between 3 & 4th Sts. as petitioned for when the weather becomes permissible, ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by ald. Smith that action be deferred until next regular meeting, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Petition to pipe

ditch along 12th St. denied.

Chairman Platt of the S & A Com. reported unfavorable upon the petition to have the ditch running along 12th St. piped, there was no action taken by Council.

Petition to

lay xing on 11th St. Grand denied

Chairman Platt of the S & A. Com. reported unfavorable upon the petition to have a Cement Crossing laid on the north side of Grand ave Crossing 11th St. thereupon ald. Boyle made a motion seconded by ald. Norris that the ~~petition~~ report be accepted and affirmed, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Chairman Platt of the S & A Com reported favorable upon the petition to have a water box put in

Water box to be laid 7th & Peller

on 7th & Peller ave. thereupon ald Norris made a motion seconded by ald. Boyle that the report of Com. be sustained, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

No definite action taken on guttering 4th St. & alley

Chairman Platt of the S&A Com. stated that the Com. were ^{not willing} ~~unable~~ to report upon the petition to have the alley between main & Colo. ave and 4th & 5th St and the east side of 4th betwain main & Colo. ave guttered. there was no definite action taken.

Chairman Norris of the F&P. Com. stated that the Com. desired further time to report upon the petition to condemn the building located at 532 main St. the Com. were granted further time.

Chairman Norris of the F&P. Com. reported favorable upon the petition of Geo. L. Hendricks for a permit to build a barn 10x14 ft. at 117 Hood ave. thereupon ald. Lutes made a motion seconded by ald. Petition to lay Water Pipe on Hill Peller denied.

Chairman Davies of the Water & Lights Com. recommended that "the petition of the Home Loan and Inv. Co to lay water pipe on Teller and Hill ave from 7th to 9th Sts. they to be reimbursed by the City when the revenue from same justified," said petition be denied without prejudice, ald. Platt made a motion seconded by ald. Boyle that the report of Com. be sustained and affirmed, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Com. on Anderson Case given further time.

ald. Davies, Mr. Cullach and Lutes of the special Com. appointed to investigate and try to effect a compromise in the Anderson case against the City of Grand Jet, recommended that a settlement should be made if possible, City Atty Colles requested to go on record as being unalterably opposed to a settlement only through the Courts, of either of the suits entered against the City by the Andersons. the matter was deferred back to the Com. for further investigation and action.

Official notice given City by F. M. Kittle

An official notice of time, place and cause of injuries sustained by Frank M. Kittle vs The City of Grand Junction, was read, Atty Carnahan addressed the Council in behalf of Mr. Kittle, no action was taken at this time.
