Minutes

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular adjourned session, Mayor Bunting presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present, Alderman Davies, McCullough, Morris, Boyle & Platt, Alderman Smith arrived a few minutes late absent alderman Atkins and Peter and City Atty Cole.

The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

A Bill filed by J. N. Wheeler for \$1008.00 was read, this Bill included all claims of Mr. J. N. Wheeler against the City of Grand Junction for legal services as special attorney in the Kannock Creek water proposition, the special water committee J. Boyle, J. A. McCullough and W. D. Davies reported favorable for the payment of said bill, Alderman Platt made a motion seconded by alderman Morris that the report of special water committee be accepted and the bill be passed and allowed provided that J. N. Wheeler give a clear receipt in lieu of all his personal claims against the City of Grand Junction, Colorado to date, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

appointed to try and effect a settlement in the Anderson case reported that the committee were in favor of a settlement but they were not willing to urge it on the Council Mr. Davies stated that Mr. Wheeler Counsel for the Anderson offered now to compromise for the sum of \$2500.00 and costs for the two cases, Alderman Platt made a motion seconded by alderman Morris that a vote of thanks be extended to the committee for their efforts and that the matter be laid on the table, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that The Colorado Commercial Company, or and hereby is, authorized and permitted to construct, operate

and maintain a railroad switch across South Avenue at ~~some~~^{the} point, shown on plat between 6th and 7th Streets, and also extending across the alley in Block 149, and which said switch is to be constructed and maintained by said Company solely upon condition that the said Company and its assigns construct and maintain the same upon grade and in good safe condition, with safe and permanent approaches on either side thereof, and with plants of good, suitable and substantial material, planting either side thereof for a reasonable distance, and also between rails and that the same be at all times, maintained by said company at its own cost and expense, and that said Company and its assigns, as a further consideration for this privilege, shall at all times save and keep harmless, the City of Grand Junction, for or on account of any loss, injury or damage that may accrue by reason of its failure so to construct, keep and maintain the said switch across said South street and said alley in safe and suitable condition for all time so long as the said switch shall be maintained, kept, used or remain therin.
