com. recommend whom was referred the matter of procuring special counsel to  
 Logan & Carnahan prosecute the suit for the condemnation of the waters of Karmah  
 Creek for the use of the City, do hereby report that after  
 considering the matter fully, we recommend the employment of  
 S.M. Logan and J.S. Carnahan, jointly as special counsel for  
 the City to prosecute said suit, on the following terms, viz:

Twenty Five Hundred Dollars for  
 attorney fees for the prosecution of said suit to final  
 termination, payable - One Third when contract is signed,  
 one third when decree or judgment is entered in the  
 District Court and the balance when the suit is  
 finally terminated.
