Upon call of roll the following responded, Aldermen Davies, Flynn, Hertz, Hudson, Matthews, Plank and City Attorney Rozzelle, Mayor Wentworth presiding.

Alderman Davies made a motion seconded by Alderman Matthews that the regular order of business be suspended and the business under call be transacted, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Alderman Plank introduced the following resolution,

Be it resolved by the City Council of

the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying the expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, for the fiscal year beginning April 1st, 1908 and ending March 31st, 1909, there be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the taxable property within the corporate limits of said City of Grand Junction, both real and personal, the following amounts for special and general taxes, namely;

First -- For the purpose of defraying the annual interest on water works bonds, issued in the years 1897 and 1899, a special tax of  $(3\frac{1}{3})$  Three and one third mills, on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed,

Second -- For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of a free public library  $(\frac{4}{5})$  Four fifths of one mill on each dollar so assessed, or to be assessed.

Third -- For the purpose of defraying the general expenses and liabilities of the City of Grand Junction,  $(19\frac{1}{5})$  Nineteen and thirteenth fiftieths mills on each dollar so assessed, or to be assessed.

And be it further resolved that the City Clerk be and hereby is directed and instructed to certify this levy to the County Clerk of Mesa County, Colorado, for levy by the Board of County Commissioners of said County as required by law.

Whereupon Alderman Davies made a motion seconded by Alderman Flynn that the resolution introduced by Alderman Plank be passed and adopted, upon Roll call the following voted aye Aldermen Davies, Flynn, Hertz, Hudson, Matthews and Plank thereupon the Presiding officer declared the motion carried.

A motion to adjourn was made seconded, put and carried.
