Roll Call

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session, Mayor Westworth presiding, upon call of roll the following responded present Aldermen Davies, Bayar, Hertz, Hudson, Plank and City Atty Ruzzell old. Drew arrived a few minutes late, absent Alderman Flynn & Matthews,

The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

The City Engineers report on the matter of construction of walks by Y. M. C. A. was ^{read} as follows:

First:-- There is a discrepancy between the plans and the specifications as regards the spacing of the reinforcing rods. The plans provide for spacing of 2 feet center to center above in the matter of the mixture of cement, sand and gravel for use in the making of concrete, the specifications call for 1 part cement to 6 parts sand and gravel, but does not specify what part is to be sand and what part gravel, this should be definite, but inasmuch as river run gravel contains nearly the proper proportions of sand and gravel, to make good concrete and as that is the material that will probably be used, this point may I think be safely ignored. Finally, if the specifications are adhered to as regards the spacing of the reinforcing bars instead of the plans, and the plans and specifications followed as they appear in all other respects, it is my judgement that the walks and the outer walls supporting them will be entirely satisfactory as regards safety and strength.
