purchasedIn the matter of purchasing a fire team and new hose as recommended by Fire Chief Rogers. ^{The Fire Police Com. reported as follows} We recommend the purchase of 500 feet of hose & Anderson Couplings for same & old hose be equipped with Anderson Couplings to make the 1000 feet, on account of the fire team being too light we recommend the sale of this team and the purchase of a heavier team, ald.
