5 foot walk on south side of White ave between 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Streets.

5 foot walk on east side of 3<sup>rd</sup> from Rood ave to alley between Rood and White avenues.

5 foot walk on both sides of White ave from first to third Street.

5 foot walk on west side of 4<sup>th</sup> St. White to Rood avenues.

5 foot walk on south side of White ave between 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> Streets. thereupon ald. Davies made a motion seconded by ald.
