The City Council of the City of Grand Junction in regular session at the Council Chamber in the City Hall in said City on Tuesday May 12<sup>th</sup> at the hour of 8 Pm. Pursuant to the rules of the Council.

The minutes of previous meeting were read and approved.

J. Berger asks for  
Building Permit

Isaac Berger petitioned for a permit to erect a porch on the rear of the building located at 328 Colorado Ave, this was referred to the Committee on Fire & Police.

Pet. for Water main on  
Chipata bet. 9+10

J. C. Caldwell and 4 others petitioned for a water main to be laid on Chipata Ave between 9th & 10th streets, this was referred to the Water Sewer & Light Com.

Pet. for Water main on  
Teller ave 3 to 5

J. H. Rankin and ten others petitioned for a water main to be laid on Teller Ave from Fifth Street to Third Street this was referred to the Water Sewer & Light Com.

The following reports of officers were read; City Treasurer, City Clerk, Water Supt, City Weigher, Police Magistrate.

Grade Streets

The Street & Alley Com. recommended that the following streets be graded Belford between 5th & 7th, Teller between 6th & 7th, Chipata bet. 7th & 8th, thereupon Ald. Davies made a motion

seconded by ald. Plank that the report of the Committee be adopted and confirmed, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

The Street and alley Com. recommended that the following sidewalks be ordered laid;

South side main from alley bet. 6 & 7<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> St.

ald. Flynn made a motion seconded by Davies, that the report of the Com. be adopted and the sidewalks be ordered laid, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously. <sup>The Street & alley com reported that they had completed the arrangements for opening up a street in Crawford</sup> ald. Hertz introduced the following resolution.

### Resolution.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction as follows:

Resolution to buy lots and open street in Crawford addition

First. That the report of the Committee on streets, and alleys pertaining to the purchase of certain lots or parcels of ground in Crawford addition to be used in opening the street between Fairview and main street be accepted.

Second. That the sum of fifteen Hundred & eighty five Dollars be paid to the owners of said ground. Said sum to be paid as soon as proper conveyance is made to the city and abstract of title furnished showing title to be free and unencumbered.

Third. Said sum of fifteen Hundred & eighty five Dollars to be paid as follows to the respective owners of said property.

Hudson that the report of H. E. Mulnix be accepted and placed <sup>on</sup> file, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Draw Warrants from General Fund to pay for lots in Cranford add Ald. Hudson made a motion seconded by Ald. Hertz that the money to be paid for the lots in Cranford addition be taken from the General Fund of the City, upon call of roll the following voted aye; Aldermen Davies, Drew, Flynn, Hertz Hudson, Matthews and Plank.

City Engin to make permanent location Street in Cranford Ald. Matthews made a motion seconded by Ald. Hudson that the City Engineer be instructed to make permanent location on the street to be opened up in Cranford add. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Fire Chief petitions for more salary Fire Chief Rogers filed a petition requesting Council to pay him a salary of \$25<sup>00</sup> per month for acting as Jailor also that he receive 20% of the City seal receipts, he also recommended that the City purchase one cellar pipe and another Anderson nozzle, this was referred to the Fire & Police Com.

City Engin to procure deed for right of way across Gen Palmers land City Engineer Omalley filed the correspondence that passed between General Palmer and him, in regard to a right of way across General Palmers land for the City pipe line. Ald. Davies made a motion seconded by Ald. Hudson that the City Engineer <sup>in conjunction with the City attorney</sup> be empowered to secure the proper deeds for right of way across General Palmers land for the City's water pipe line, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
