The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session at the Council Chamber in the City Hall in said City on Tuesday June 23rd at the hour of 8 Pm, pursuant to the rules of the Council.

were read and approved.

a communication received from

Ball Player ^{and} the base ball association was read, they asked the City Council \$150.⁰⁰ to donate the sum of \$150.⁰⁰ to purchase ball suits for the Ball Team, this was referred to the Finance Committee.

permit to erect a shooting gallery on lot 2 Block 125, this was referred to the Fire and Police Committee with power to act, on motion made by Matthews seconded by Hudson which carried unanimously.

Plumbing license, this was referred to the Water, Sewer & Lights Com.

W. P. Skidmore

refused license for a saloon at lot 16 Block 143. thereupon Alderman Boyer made a motion seconded by Alderman Hudson that the report of the license Committee be accepted and sustained, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Book Cliff Ry

secure contract for coal. The Water Sewer and Light Committee recommended that the bid for coal to be furnished the Grand City Water Works be awarded to the Book Cliff Ry as per their bid of 4 in. run \$1.75 per ton, but \$2.40 per ton and slack \$1.30 per ton. Alderman Matthews moved seconded by Ald. Hudson, that the report of the committee be accepted and the contract be awarded to the Book Cliff Ry. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Reports of Fire

& Police Com. that the salary of the Fire Chief be raised \$15.⁰⁰ per month, and that one more man be placed on the Fire department. This was referred back to the Committee for further report.

for further report. The Fire & Police Com. recommended that an additional room be built on the rear of the Fire Hall for storing Hay & Grain, thereupon Ald. Boyer made a motion seconded by Ald. Hudson that this matter be referred back to the Committee and that they furnish Plans & specifications covering cost of same, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Bond approved for Fire Police. The Finance Committee recommended that the Bond furnished by G. P. Rogers to act as special Policeman be accepted. thereupon Alderman Boyer entered a motion seconded by Ald. Hudson that the report of the Finance Committee be accepted and the Bond be placed on file, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Alderman Davies made a motion seconded by Alderman Flynn that said petition be referred to the street and alley Committee with power to act. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

A communication received from the Western Street Directory Co. was read they desired to modify their petition presented and passed upon at the meeting held June 9th.

Ald. Hertz made a motion seconded by Ald. Davies requesting the City Atty to give an opinion as to whether the City Council acted within their authority when they granted the Western Street Directory Co. permission to use the streets for advertising purposes. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

City Atty Rozzelle rendered an opinion that the City Council has no authority to grant permission to use of streets for private purposes.

Thereupon Ald. Flynn moved seconded by Ald. Davies that the action taken by the Council on June 9th in regard to the granting a permit to the Western Street Directory Co. to use the streets for advertising purposes be rescinded, upon roll call the vote was as follows. Alderman Davies yea, Boyer nay, Flynn yea, Hertz yea, Hudson nay, Matthews nay the result of the vote being a tie the Mayor voted yea and declared the motion carried.
