

Grand Junction Colorado.

July 14th 1908

The City Council of the city of Grand Junction, met in regular session at the Council Chamber in the city hall in said city on Tuesday evening July 14th at the hour of 8:15 P.M. pursuant to the rules of the Council.

Roll Call

The session was called to order by Mayor J. P. Wentworth, when the roll was called, the following members of the Council responding present. W. D. Davies, A. P. Drew, M. Hertz, C. F. Hudson, J. B. Matthews and J. C. Plaut. Also Pres. J. P. Wentworth, Mayor, and Leon J. Chapman, acting clerk in the absence of Clerk John M. Conley. Absent, Aldermen M. H. Flynn and W. C. Bayer, and City Attorney Roggelle.

Minutes

Approved

The minutes of the Council session held June 23rd-08 were read and approved, a motion prevailing to waive the reading of the bills.

Petitions by
BC Isenmayer

BC Isenmayer petitioned the Council for permission to construct frame work sufficient to hold up corrugated iron roof, said roof to cover space of about 25 x 32 feet. Structure to be left open at ends and sides, and used as shelter for machinery and erected on the rear of lot 12 block 126, of the City of Grand Jct. Colo. Mayor Wentworth referred the petition to the Fire and Police Comm.

Petitions

A petition signed by Otto A. Shick, H. Robinson, M. O. Delaplaine, G. M. Hagner, C. S. Baker and P. H. Fisher, asking for the laying of a cement sidewalk on the North side of Curvey Ave. between Tenth and Twelfth streets, the city to lay the intersecting crossings, was presented to the Council. Mayor Wentworth referred the petition to the Street and Alley Committee.

Colo Telephone
Petitions

Mr. G. W. Pugh, manager of the Colorado Telephone Co. for Grand Junction, addressed the Mayor and members of the Council in reference to being permitted to place poles on 11th street from the alley south of Colorado Ave, north to the alley south of Chipeta avenue. Alderman Matthews moved the following motion which was seconded by Alderman Plaut. "That the request of The Colorado Telephone Company to erect telephone line on Eleventh Street

be denied and that the Colorado Telephone Company in the future be required to confine its lines to the alleys as required by Ordinance No 37." Upon call for vote the following Aldermen voted Yea, Davis, Drew, Hertz, Hudson, Matthews, and Plank. Mayor Wentworth declared the motion carried unanimously.

A communication from City Attorney Rozzelle giving an opinion on the bill presented by Oliver Hebert for services as Registrar, was read and upon motion

by Alderman Matthews seconded by Alderman Davis, which duly carried, the communication presented by City Attorney Poyzelle was accepted and placed on file and the decision sustained.

Agreement for Right of Way over D & R G Tracks

A communication from the Denver and Rio Grande P.R. to which was attached agreement for Right of way for pipeline across Railroad tracks at Pumping station was presented to the council and a motion by Alderman Matthews seconded by Alderman Hudson, referring the matter to the water & Sewer Committee, duly carried.

That the Book Cliff Railroad Company's bid to furnish said city with coal for its pumping station, be accepted at the prices therein quoted, to wit:

Slack Coal \$ 1.30 per ton.

Mine Run coal \$ 1.75 per ton.

Said coal to be furnished and to be delivered at said City's pumping station south of said city near the Gunnison River; said coal to be paid for from month to month as the bills are presented and allowed; said coal to be weighed at the City scales of the said city and the weights thereof to control in payment therefor. Objection to Granting Electric Railway Franchise

A communication signed by Nellie S. Russell, Owner lot 18, Blk 89, Laura F. Chapman, owner lot 18 Blk 88, Jas Murphy owner lots 1 to 6 Keiths Addition, and Chris F. Lass, owner lots 16 & 17 Blk 88, was presented, asking the withdrawal of their names from the petition heretofore signed, in favor of Horace K. Devereaux and Eugene U. Sunderland, for the rights to construct, operate and maintain an Electric Railway in Grand Junction. The reason offered for asking the withdrawal of their names being that they objected to the operation of freight cars and trains on said 12th St.
