Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, that the sum of Thirteen Thousand Five Hundred (\$13,500.00) Dollars, now in the hands of the City Treasurer, as a part of the Special Water Fund be transferred from said special fund to the regular Water Fund, and to be used for the purpose of taking up outstanding Water Warrants.
