The Grand Jct. Elec. Gas & Mfg. Co. petitioned Council to grant them a rate of 8¢ per thousand gallons for water used. this was referred to the water committee.

Street Railway
ask for grade
lines

The Fruit Belt Power and Irrigation Co. requested that the City Engineer fix and establish required grade on the following streets, viz: 12th St. from North Ave. south to Pitkin Ave; on Pitkin Ave, between 11th and 12th Streets; on 11th St. between Pitkin and South Ave; on South Ave. to 7th St. and on 7th St. south to City limits. ald. Davies made a motion seconded by ald. Hudson that the City Engineer be instructed to give such surveys for grade as is required by franchise. upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.

Harry Burnett made a verbal

request for a permit to erect a third story on the St. Regis Hotel, this was referred to the Fire & Police Committee.

Sidewalks ordered laid

The Street & Alley Com. recommended that sidewalks be ordered laid on the north side of Chipeta ave. between 7th & 8th streets. thereupon ald. Davies made a motion seconded by ald. Plank that the report of the committee be sustained and the walks be ordered laid, upon call of motion said motion carried unanimously.
