alderman Plank introduced a tax levy
 resolution and moved its adoption seconded by ald. Davies
 "Resolution"
 Be it resolved by the City Council of

the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of said City of Grand Junction for the fiscal year beginning April the 1st 1909 and ending March 31st 1910, there shall be and hereby is levied and assessed that on the taxable property within the limits of said City of Grand Junction both real and personal the following amounts for special and general tax, to wit;

1st For the purpose of defraying the annual interest on outstanding water bonds issued in the years of 1897, 1899 and 1908 a special tax of Five Mills (.005) on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

2nd For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of the free public library three-fourths ($\frac{3}{4}$) of one mill on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

3rd For the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of said City of Grand Junction a tax of Nineteen and One Fourth ~~with~~ ($19\frac{1}{4}$) Mills is hereby assessed on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed, and, Be It Further Resolved that the City Clerk is hereby directed and instructed to certify this levy to the County Clerk of Mesa County, Colorado, for levy by the vote of the County Commissioners as it is required by law.
