

Grand Junction Colo. Apr 27<sup>th</sup> 1909

The city council of the city of Grand Junction Colo. convened in regular session at 8 o'clock P.M. Mayor Lee presiding

Roll call. Upon call of roll following responded as present: Campbell Drew: Derryberry: Gasko: Holman: Magill: McCarry: Waldroup. Minutes of last meeting were read and approved.

Mr. J. S. Carnahan appeared before the council and made a statement to council of the legal work done by himself and Mr. Stourd. M. Logon in the matter of Kanab Creek water condemnation up to date.

Petition of Halligan to grant him renewal of his commission as special policeman.

From 11<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> on Colman ave: From Colman ave. to Main on  
12<sup>th</sup> st. From 8<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> on Pittin.

"We find that it will require 3770 feet of pipe, 3 hydrants  
6x6 valves &c. to make the extension at an approximate cost  
of \$2800. We further recommend that a car of pipe  
be bought and the above extensions be made.
