

Grand Junction Colo. May 25th 1909

A regular meeting of the city council was held this evening. Meeting was called to order at 8 o'clock; Mayor Lee presiding.

Roll Call.

Upon call of roll the following aldermen responded present Campbell, Derryberry, Drew, Gasto, Holman, McCary, Magill, Waldroup.

Cement walks
ordered on
various streets.

Moved by Ald. Gasto, and seconded by Ald. Waldroup that board walks on following streets be condemned, and cement walks put in: On west side of 4th st. from Main to Teller; On east side of 4th st. from Main to Garrison; On west side of 3rd st. from Main to Teller; On east of 3rd st. from Main to Teller. On north side of Main st. from 9th to 12th Sts.

Upon call of motion, the clerk called the roll, and each Alderman present voted as follows.

Campbell yea, Derryberry yea, Drew yea, Gasto yea, Holman yea, McCary yea, Magill yea, Waldroup yea. All of the Aldermen having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Communication from School Board was read, relating to vacation of alley in block 47; referred to Streets and Alley Committee.

Adjourned.

Moved by Ald. Magill, and seconded by Ald. Campbell that Council adjourn to meet on Thursday May 27th 1909 at 8 o'clock P.M. Motion carried. Adjourned.
