

Grand Junction July 27th 1909

The city Council convened in regular session this evening at 8 o'clock: Mayor Lee presiding.

The clerk called the roll to which the following Aldermen responded as present.

The minutes of the last regular meeting were read and approved.

Petition signed by Wm. Milne and seven others was read, praying council to order Water Main laid on Chipeta Ave. between 10th & 12th Sts.

Referred to Water & Lights committee.

Petition signed by W. F. Kennedy was read, praying council to grant the use of Walnut Park for placing tents during camp-meeting Sept. 16 to 26th for 7th day adventists.

Moved by Ald. Campbell and seconded by Ald. Magill that petition be not granted.

Upon call of motion, same carried unanimously.

Moved by Ald. McCarry and seconded by Ald. Easton that petitioners be granted the use of Chestnut Park provided proper sanitary precautions are used.

Upon call of motion, same carried unanimously.

Finance committee reported that they had carefully examined and checked the reports of City Treasurer: City Clerk: City Weigher: Police Magistrate, and Water Supt. for months of May and June, and report of Chief of Fire Department for quarter ending June 30th 1909 and find them correct.
