

Grand Junction, Colo. Aug. 24th 1909

The city Council convened in a regular meeting this evening at 8 o'clock; Mayor Lee presiding. The clerk called the roll, to which the following responded as present.

Campbell; Gasho; Holman; Magill. Ald. McCary and Ald. Waldroup entered the Chamber during the reading of the minutes of last meeting.

The clerk read the minutes of the last regular meeting, which were approved.

A petition signed by W. H. Patton and three other persons was read, praying council to grant permission to allow petitioners to lay new sidewalk one foot further east than the established two feet from property line.

Moved by Ald. Campbell, and seconded by Ald. Magill that prayer of petitioners be granted.

The motion being put, the clerk called the roll, whereupon each Alderman as his name was called voted as follows. Campbell yea, Gasho yea, Holman yea, McCary yea, Magill yea, Waldroup yea. All the Aldermen present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

A petition signed by A. O. Arnold, and twelve other persons was read praying council to order sidewalk laid on the south side of Ourray Ave. from 9th to 12th Sts.

Referred by the Mayor to Street & Alley committee.

A petition signed by Dr. W. V. Mills and eleven other persons was read, praying council to extend the water mains on Hill ave east to 12th st. and on Teller ave. from 7th to 12th Sts.

Referred by the Mayor to Water & Light committee.

A petition signed by J. E. Whittemore, and twenty three other persons was read, praying council to order an Arc. Light placed at the corner of Ourray ave. and 9th st. Referred by the Mayor to Water & Light Com.

A representative of the Hartford Steam Boiler Insurance Co. addressed the council on the subject of insuring city boilers.

Moved by Ald. Campbell, and seconded by Ald. Holman that matter be referred to committee on Water & Lights. Upon call of motion, same carried unanimously.

Moved by Ald. Magill, and seconded by Ald. Gasho that Street + Alley committee confer with City Attorney and investigate in regard to a crossing over R.R. tracks south of Colorado ave. in Cranford add.

Upon call of motion, same was declared by the Mayor carried.

Moved by Ald. M^cCary, and seconded by Ald. Magill that City Attorney be instructed to dismiss case pending against A.B. Campbell on charge of carrying horse in city limits.

Moved by Ald. Gasho, and seconded by Ald. Holman to amend motion as follows: City attorney be instructed to investigate the evidence in the case, and report at next meeting of the council.

Upon call of amended motion, same was declared by the Mayor carried. Original motion was then called, and it was declared by the Mayor carried.

Moved by Ald. Gasho that Chief of Police be instructed to order his force to gather up Hobo's and put them to work. Motion not seconded.

Moved by Ald. Campbell, and seconded by Ald. M^cCary that Council adjourn to Tuesday Aug. 31st at 8 o'clock P.M.
