Whereas the said Council did by said resolution designate Tuesday, October 12th, as the day when the owner of the said lot or his agent might appear before the city council and be heard as to the justness and correctness of the amount so certified and assessed against the said lot 1, and

Whereas the City Clerk has caused to be published in the Daily News, a daily newspaper published in said city, for a period of ten days a notice to the owner of said lot, setting forth the time and place designated as aforesaid as appears from the affidavit of publication of said notice, now on file with the said City Clerk, and

Whereas neither the owner of said lot or any agent or other person for him did appear at the time and place designated for hearing objections as to the justness and correctness of said assessment, and

Now therefore Be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction:

That the said clerk be, and he is hereby authorized and instructed to certify to the County Clerk and Recorder of Mesa County the assessment of One hundred and one (\$101⁰⁰) dollars together with the sum of Ten dollars and ten cents (\$10¹⁰), as penalty thereon to defray the cost of collection, the said sum of One hundred and eleven ¹⁰/₁₀₀ (\$111¹⁰) dollars, to be by said County Clerk and Recorder, placed upon the tax list for the current year, to be collected in the same manner as other taxes are collected.
