

Grand Junction Oct. 27th 1909

The City Council convened in adjourned session this evening at 8 o' clock, Mayor Lee presiding.

The clerk called the roll, to which the following Aldermen responded as present. Roll Call. Campbell, Drew, Gasho, Holman, M^cCary, Magill.

Permit for Wm. Neurr to place Pilaster of his building on Lots # 25 + 26 in Block # 102, eight inches forward from lot line was taken up and discussed.

Moved by Ald. M^cCary, and seconded by Ald. Holman that permit be granted. Upon call of motion, same was declared by Mayor carried.

Council Addressed by J. M. Rozzelle reference to his contract. Council was addressed by J. M. Rozzelle on the subject of his contract with city for revising and compiling City Ordinances.

Moved by Ald. Holman, and seconded by Ald. Gasho

that motion instructing City Attorney to bring suit against J. W. Rozelle be reconsidered, and matter laid on the table for Charter Commission to dispose of.
