

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 9, 1909  
Council Chamber, City Hall.

The newly-elected Commissioners of the City of Grand Junction, composing the new City Council under the Charter adopted September 14, 1909, met at 10 o'clock a.m., being called to order by Commissioner of Public Affairs Thos. M. Todd.

Roll call.

The following commissioners were present at roll call: Thos. M. Todd, Commissioners of Public Affairs; Bostwick W. Vedder, Commissioner of Water and Sewers; Herman F. Vorbeck, Commissioner of Finance and Supplies; Stephen J. Scoville, Commissioner of Highways, and Charles K. Holmberg, Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty. Absent: none.

The applications of George L. Crawford and Lloyd C. Aldrich for the position of City Engineer were presented and read.

Commissioner Vedder placed in nomination for the office of City Engineer George L. Crawford. The nomination was seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck. On roll call George L. Crawford was duly elected City Engineer by the unanimous vote of the Council.

Commissioner Vedder presented the following appointments under the Department of Water and Sewers, at the Pump House:

Tom Handle, Assistant Engineer;  
George Mason, Pumper;

Charles Garber, Construction Repairer.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg and seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the appointments presented by Commissioner Vedder for the Pump House be confirmed by the Council, and that the several appointees be paid the same salaries that they are now receiving.
