Applications for City Engineer

The applications of George L. Crawford and Lloyd C. Aldrich for the position of City Engineer were presented and read.

Election of City Engineer

Commissioner Vedder placed in nomination for the office of City Engineer George L. Crawford. The nomination was seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck. The vote was as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea. On roll call, George L. Crawford was duly elected City Engineer by the unanimous vote of the Council.

Appointments under Department of Water & Sewers.

Commissioner Vedder presented the following appointments under the Department of Water and Sewers, at the Pump House:

Charles Garber, Construction Repairer.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg and seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, that the appointments presented by Commissioner Vedder for the Pump House be confirmed by the Council, and that the several appointees be paid the same salaries that they are now receiving.
