

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 24, 1909

All the commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried, and William A. Knoche duly appointed a policeman for the city.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the Council adjourn.

The motion carried, and the Council then adjourned.
