The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session in the Council Chamber, City Hall, at 4 o'clock p. m., with Mayor Todd presiding

Petitions

The petition of C. F. Fuchs, J. Monroe Stewart and others, requesting the city to enlarge the water main on North avenue from Seventh street to Ninth street, was presented and read to the Council.

Moved by Commissioner Scovill and seconded by Commissioner Holmberg that the petition be laid on the table.

The motion carried.

The petition of The Independent Lumber Co., asking for a permit to put in a wagon scale on the south side of Main street, near the corner of Spruce street, was presented and read to the Council.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg and seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck that the petition be referred to the Commissioner of Highways for investigation.

The motion carried, and the petition was so referred.

The petition of The Western Slope Securities Company and the Rich. Hutchinson Realty Co., asking the Council to extend the incorporated limits of the City of Grand Junction to cover the boundaries of the property described in the petition, was presented and read to the Council.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck that the petition be referred to Mayor Todd, the Commissioner of Highways, the City Attorney and the City Engineer.

The motion carried, and the petition was so referred.

The communication of A. Haunah, of Delta, Colo., stating that he and associates were in a position to supply the City of Grand Junction with mountain water, was read to the Council.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the communication be referred to the Mayor and the Commissioner of Water and Sewers.
