

Grand Junction, Colorado, December 29, 1909

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in the City Hall at 12 o'clock M., pursuant to adjournment, with Mayor Todd presiding.

Upon roll call the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vorbrück, Scovill, Holmberg. Absent: Commissioner Vedder.

By unanimous consent of the Commissioners present, the regular order of business was suspended, and the City Clerk presented and read the proof of publication of the Ordinance, entitled, "Special Appropriation Ordinance for the Years 1909 and 1910."

Moved by Commissioner Vorbrück and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the proof of publication as read be accepted.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vorbrück, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.
