

Grand Junction, Colo., March 17, 1910.

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in adjourned session at 10 o'clock a.m., in the Council Chamber, City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Holmberg.

The following resolution was introduced and read to the Council:

*Resolution* Whereas, At a regular meeting of the City Council held on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1910, a motion was passed "authorizing" the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies to order a Case Road Roller, and

Whereas, It is the sense of this Council that said motion should have definitely instructed the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies to order said roller, be it therefore

Resolved, That the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be hereby instructed to order said Case Road Roller (10 ton) at the price of \$1930.00, in accordance with specifications furnished.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Holmberg that the resolution as read be adopted:

The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, no; Vedder, no; Vorbeck, ~~yea~~; Scovill, no; Holmberg, yea.

*Resolution Lost* A majority of the Commissioners having voted no, the Mayor declared the motion and resolution lost.

*Motion* Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the authority given to the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies to order a Case Road Roller, passed March 8<sup>th</sup>, be withdrawn, and that he be instructed not to order the same.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, no; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, no.

Motion  
Carried A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Scovill and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be instructed to order one 10-ton Port Huron road roller, to comply with the specifications heretofore given to this Council by the Port Huron Company.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, no; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, no.

Motion  
Carried A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Adjourned On motion of Commissioner Holmberg, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the Council adjourned.
