Regular
session

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction met in regular session this afternoon at 4 o'clock, Mayor Todd presiding.

Roll
call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Scovill, Vorbeck. Absent: Commissioner Holmberg.

The minutes of last regular and two adjourned meetings were read and approved.

Petition

The Sexton of Orchard Mesa Cemetery and a committee of ladies of the "Cemetery Improvement Association" appeared before the Council with a request that the City lay about 400 feet of inch pipe in Orchard Mesa Cemetery in order that water can be more readily distributed in said Cemetery.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Scovill, that the request

of the committee be granted and pipe asked for be laid at the City's expense.

Motion Carried
The motion being put, the clerk called the roll, whereupon each Commissioner as his name was called voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Scovill, yea; Vorbeck, yea. All the Commissioners present having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Petition for G.A.R.
N. N. Smith and a committee from the G.A.R. also a committee from the Chamber of Commerce appeared before the Council, requesting Council to make an appropriation toward defraying the expenses of the oncoming encampment of the G.A.R.

Motion to appropriate \$250.00 to G.A.R. Encampment
Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that \$250.00 be appropriated from the General Fund and turned over to the management of the Encampment.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that petition be granted and sidewalk ordered laid.

Richard Dowrey appeared before the Council requesting permission to move frame building now on the front of Lots 30, 31 and 32, Block 120, to the rear end of same lots during construction of new building on the front of said lots.
