C. E. Cherrington, Edwin Price, Wm. Bathorn and H. J. DeLong, Trustees of the Palmer Park, appeared before the Council and presented a resolution in reference to the acceptance of the artesian well as an improvement of the park under the terms of the deed made by the late General Palmer.

Dr. Carl W. Plub, City Health Officer, appeared before the Council and called attention to the necessity of door and window fly screens for the Red Mesa Hospital, and stated that the County Commissioners were willing to pay half of the expense thereof.
