In the matter of the deficiency of G. Perry Rogers, ex-Fire Chief, the City Attorney reported adversely to bringing suit against his bondmen, because the bond was given as Fire Chief and not as City Weigher, and the present ordinance does not make it a part of the duty of the Fire Chief to collect the fees of the City Weigher.

A communication from J. E. McKenzie and others, asking that Ordinance No. 176 be amended, was read to the Council. On motion of Commissioner Holmberg, seconded by Commissioner Vorbeck, the communication was referred to the Commissioner of Water and Sewers and the City Attorney.
