

Grand Junction, Colorado, August 9, 1910

Regular Meeting

The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session in the City Hall, at 4 o'clock p. m., with Commissioner Vedder in the chair.

Roll Call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Vedder, Vorbeck, Scoville, Holmburg. Absent: Mayor Todd.

Minutes Approved

City Attorney Bucklin was present. The minutes of the regular meeting of August 2 and adjourned session of August 5, were read and approved.

Concessions asked for

Dr. Charles Gasho, secretary of the Mesa County Fair Association, appeared before the Council and asked that the association be granted the concession privileges of the city for the Fair week, beginning September 20th, 1910.

Referred to Committee

On motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Scoville, the matter of granting the privileges asked for by the Fair Association, was referred to the Mayor and the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies.

Reports of City Weigher and Fire Chief Approved

Mayor Todd now reported present. The reports of the City Weigher and the Fire Chief for the month of July having been approved by the Mayor, the reports were, on motion of Commissioner Holmburg, seconded by Commissioner Scoville, accepted and ordered placed on file.

A Proposed Ordinance Introduced

A Proposed Ordinance, introduced by Commissioner Vorbeck and entitled, "An Ordinance amending Section 8 of Article II of Ordinance Number 92 entitled 'An Ordinance Concerning water works and to repeal certain other ordinances,' passed and adopted the 19th day of February, A. D. 1900," was read by the clerk.

Passed for Publication

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Holmburg, that the proposed Ordinance as read, be passed for publication.

The motion being put upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Holmberg that the Commissioner of Highways and the City Engineer be instructed to go to Salt Lake City to investigate the street paving now being done in that city and learn what they can about street paving in general. The motion carried.

On motion of Commissioner Holmberg, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the Council adjourned to Friday, August 12, at 4 o'clock p. m.
