Roll Call

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Holmburg.

Introduced

A proposed Ordinance, entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for an Emergency Appropriation for the Maintenance of the Department of Water and Sewers," was introduced by Commissioner Vedder.

and read to the Council by the Clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the ordinance as read and entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for an Emergency Appropriation for the Maintenance of the Department of Water and Sewers," be passed and adopted as an emergency ordinance, and that the same be ordered published once in full in the Daily News.

Emergency Appropriation Ordinance Passed and Adopted
The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried, and the ordinance passed as an emergency ordinance by a unanimous vote of the Council.
