 The following resolution was introduced and read to the Council:

Whereas, the Council finds that sufficient sidewalks have been laid on the south side of Gunnison avenue, between Seventh and Eighth streets and immediately north of Block 49 in the City of Grand Junction, State of Colorado, to make it reasonable and proper that all intervening or vacant sidewalk areas in said territory should be laid, and the Council further finds the sidewalk area on the south side of Gunnison avenue immediately in front of lot eleven in Block 49 in the City of Grand Junction is the only sidewalk area in said territory now without sidewalk; Therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Council hereby orders the construction by the owner of a sidewalk in accordance with the ordinances of the City of Grand Junction to be built on the south side of Gunnison Avenue immediately in front of Lot eleven in Block 49 in the City of Grand Junction, and the owner of said Lot eleven shall be so notified by the Commissioner of Highways in accordance with Section 12 of Ordinance number 78 of the City of Grand Junction.
