

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 4, 1910.

Adjourned Session The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in adjourned session at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Holmberg.

Proof of Publication The proof of publication of the proposed Ordinance, entitled, "An Ordinance Providing for the Erection of Signs and the Maintenance of the Same in a Safe Condition and Providing Penalties for a Violation of the Provisions of the Ordinance," was presented and read.

Accepted Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the proof of publication as read be accepted and placed on file. The motion carried.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the proposed Ordinance be taken up for final passage.

Upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried.

The proposed ordinance was then read by the clerk.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that proposed ordinance as read, and entitled "An Ordinance Providing for the Erection of Signs and the Maintenance of the Same in a Safe Condition and Providing Penalties for a Violation of the Provisions of the Ordinance," be passed and adopted.

Proposed Ordinance Passed and Adopted The motion being put, each Commissioner as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, no; Holmberg, yea.

A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion

carried and the proposed ordinance passed and adopted.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the bond accepted.

Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Scovill that the call for the special city election, to submit the water and sewer propositions, ^{be deferred} until after a verdict has been rendered by the jury in the trial of the Kaunah Creek case now pending in the District Court.

The motion being put, upon call of roll the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, no; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, no; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

A majority of the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.
