

Grand Junction, Colorado, November 23, 1910.

Adjourned
Session

Pursuant to adjournment, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened at 9 o'clock a.m. in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the Chair.

Roll call

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Norbeck, Scovill, Holmberg.

The following resolution was introduced and read to the Council:

Be it Resolved, By the City Council of the City of Grand Junction, Colorado, that for the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of the said City of Grand Junction for the next fiscal year, beginning January 1, 1911, and ending December 31, 1911, there shall be and hereby is levied and assessed upon all the taxable property situated within the corporate limits of said City of Grand Junction, both real and personal, the following amounts for

special and general taxes, to-wit:

1st. For the purpose of defraying the annual interest on outstanding water works bonds, a special tax of three and three-fourths ($3\frac{3}{4}$) mills on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

2^d. For the purpose of defraying the expenses and maintenance of the free Public Library, a tax of three-fourths of one ($\frac{3}{4}$ of 1) mill on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed.

3^d For the purpose of defraying the necessary expenses and liabilities of said City of Grand Junction, a tax of twenty-two and one-fourth ($22\frac{1}{4}$) mills is hereby assessed on each dollar of said property so assessed or to be assessed; and be it further

Resolved, That the City Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and instructed to certify to the foregoing levy to the County Clerk and Recorder, and also to the County Assessor, of Mesa County, Colorado, for levy by the vote of the County Commissioners, as required by the Statutes of the State of Colorado, and as provided also by the Charter of the said City of Grand Junction.

Moved, by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the resolution as read be adopted.

The motion being put, each Commissioner, as his name was called, voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Scovill, yea; Holmberg, yea.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted.
