Regular session The City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in regular session, at 4 o'clock p.m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

Roll call Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Kolmburg.

Minutes Approved The minutes of the regular meeting of December 27<sup>th</sup>; adjourned session of December 28<sup>th</sup>; and special meetings of December 30<sup>th</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1910, were read and approved.

Annual Report of Fire Chief Referred The annual report of the Fire Chief and City Weigher was presented and read to the Council, and on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Vedder, the report was referred to the Commissioner of Public Affairs.

Quarterly Report of Com. of Health and Sewers The quarterly report of the Commissioner of Water and Sewers, for the quarter ending December 31<sup>st</sup>, 1910, was presented and read to the Council.

Quarterly Report of Com. of Health and Civic Beauty On motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the report was referred to the auditor.

Quarterly Report of Com. of Health and Civic Beauty The quarterly report of the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty was presented and read to the Council, and on motion of Commissioner Vedder, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the report was referred to the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies.

Report of Plumbing Inspector The quarterly report of the Plumbing Inspector was read to the Council, and on motion of Commissioner Vorbeck, seconded by Commissioner Scovill, the report was referred to the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty.

Motion to advertise for bids for collecting Garbage Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Scovill, that the Commissioner of Health and Civic Beauty be authorized to re-advertise
