All the Commissioners having been duly notified by the Mayor, the City Council of the City of Grand Junction convened in special session at 12 o'clock m., in the City Hall, with Mayor Todd in the chair.

The following Commissioners, upon call of roll, responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Scovill, Kolmburg.

The following resolution was introduced and read:

Whereas, Many of the water consumers have appeared before the City Commissioners protesting against the provisions of Ordinance No. 181 on the plea that there is at this time a condition existing among many people which makes it a hardship to pay their water rents for six months, and

Whereas, The Commissioners do not desire to place a hardship upon such consumers who are unable to pay their rents for the term of six months at this time, be it therefore

Resolved, By the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that the Commissioner of Finance and Supplies be, and hereby is, instructed to extend the time of payment of water rentals for the first half of the current year to the first day of March, without charging the penalty as provided in said Ordinance No. 181, and

Resolved, That the penalty be enforced on all unpaid rents after said first day of March, and that the Commissioner of Water and Sewers do not turn off water on unpaid places until after the 10th day of March.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried and the resolution adopted.
