The contract proposed to be entered into between the City of Grand Junction and A. C. Schwenker for the collection of garbage and cleaning of the grease traps of the city, was read by the Clerk.

Contract with A. C. Schwenker for Collection of Garbage and Cleaning of Grease Traps. Moved by Commissioner Vedder and seconded by Commissioner Holmberg that the contract as read for the collection and disposition of garbage and the cleaning of the grease traps of the City be made with A. C. Schwenker for the term of nine months from February 15th, 1911, payment for the services therein specified to be made monthly at the rate of \$425⁰⁰ per month; and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized and instructed to sign said contract for and in behalf of the City.

All the Commissioners having voted yea, the motion was declared carried. The following resolution was introduced and read:

Resolution.

Resolution declaring all city warrants issued prior to January 1st 1905, to be cancelled.

Whereas, in the last audit of the books and accounts of the City made by a certified public accountant, it was recommended that all outstanding warrants of issue prior to six years back be declared cancelled, in order that a starting point may be had for the proper balancing of the warrants account in the future, and

Whereas, the City Council believes this recommendation should be acted upon, therefore, be it

Resolved, by the City Council of the City of Grand Junction that all city warrants issued prior to January 1st, 1905, be, and the same are hereby, declared to be cancelled.

Moved by Commissioner Vorbick, seconded by Commissioner Holmberg, that the resolution as read be passed and adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Holmberg and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the Commissioner of Highways and the Mayor be appointed a special committee to investigate the matter of procuring a gravel bed for the city.

The motion carried.
