

Grand Junction, Colorado, March 20, 1911

Special Meeting

All the Commissioners having been duly notified thereof by the Mayor, a special meeting of the City Council of the City of Grand Junction was held in the City Hall, being called to order at 5 o'clock p.m., by Mayor Todd.

Roll call.

Upon call of roll, the following Commissioners responded as present: Todd, Vedder, Vorbeck, Kolmburg. Absent: Commissioner Scovill.

Proposal from Wm. E. Sweet & Co. for purchase of Special Assessment Bonds.

A communication from Wm. E. Sweet & Company was read by the Clerk, which communication submitted a proposition for the purchase of the Thirty-five Thousand (\$35,000) Dollar six per cent Special Assessment Sewer Bonds, or such part thereof as may be issued; the said Wm. E. Sweet & Co. offering to pay the City, Five Hundred Dollars for each Five Hundred Dollar Bond, less a commission of two per cent. for legal expense, et cetera; the City to deliver to the said Sweet & Co. Twenty-five Thousand Dollars of the Bonds on or before May 10, 1911, the balance of the issue to be delivered when additional funds are needed by the City for their work on Sanitary Sewer District No. 3; it being understood that the proposed contract is made contingent upon the proposition carrying at the Special Election.

Motion carried

Moved by Commissioner Vorbeck and seconded by Commissioner Vedder that the proposed contract as read ~~be~~ entered into with Wm. E. Sweet & Company, and that the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized <sup>and instructed</sup> to sign the same for the City.

The motion being put, upon call of roll, the Commissioners voted as follows: Todd, yea; Vedder, yea; Vorbeck, yea; Kolmburg, yea.

All the Commissioners present having

voted yea, the Mayor declared the motion carried.
